What do Camp Christopher volunteers do?

Kitchens: With our Kitchen Manager and Kitchen Assistant, kitchen volunteers help to prepare meals that our cook has planned. You have breaks throughout the day and in the evening. The kitchen is at the heart of camp, a fun and energetic place where you can get to know new people while you laugh, talk and work!

Maintenance: The tasks of volunteers vary week to week. Our Maintenance Manager organizes the repairs, painting, building and site work that needs to be done for the week. We like to consider the interests and gifts of volunteers and perhaps there is a special project you would like to work on while you are at camp.

First Aiders: Each week our campers and staff are cared for by qualified health staff. First Aiders must have one of the following qualifications: R.N., M.D. Standard First Aid Certificate, or C.N.A..

How do I become a volunteer?

1. Complete both parts of the form.
2. Obtain a Police Record check (If it is not already on file at camp we can provide you with a volunteer letter to take to the police station. This way you won't have to pay for your Check).
3. We will be in touch with confirmation after we receive your form!

There are several options for accommodations for volunteers depending on the number of volunteers and campers per week. There are cabins with single beds, and bunk beds in our main lodge. You are also welcome to bring a trailer or tent and camp on the site.
