

Waterfront Director

Camp Director and Camp Administrator

Job Purpose:

The Waterfront Director is responsible for all aspects of the beach and waterfront.

Primary Responsibilities:

1. Beachfront Supervision & Program
2. Canoe/kayak Instruction
3. Adventure Leadership

Duties and Responsibilities:

The Waterfront Director is expected to:

1. Model good Christian leadership, in accordance with the philosophy and purpose of Camp Christopher.
2. Work in team with the Program Director and Leadership Director in the area of program development and leadership.
3. Set up and maintain the waterfront area. Plan and supervise all water activities.
4. Implement the "buddy system" and practice emergency procedures regularly.
5. Regularly check waterfront equipment and report needs to the Administrator.
6. Coordinate the Canoe Camp and overnights. This includes meeting and consulting with the trip leadership team prior to and during the onsite program (with the Leadership Director).
7. Supervise and provide leadership for the Adventure education program.

Qualifications

- He/She must have the following minimum qualifications (per SCA standards):
 - have current NLA Certificate
 - at least 18 years of age
 - able to provide basic canoe/kayak instruction
 - First Aid and CPR C
